I saw the prevaricators and I pined away, because they have not kept your word.
See how I have loved your commandments; O Lord, enliven me in your mercy.
The beginning of your words is truth; all the judgments of your justice are forever.

I have hated and abhorred iniquity; but I have loved your law.

I waited for your salvation, O Lord, and I loved your commandments.

My soul has kept your testimonies, and I have loved them greatly.

I have kept your commandments and your testimonies, for all my ways are in your sight.
